Inter-operability of the European high-speed train network

1994/0112(SYN) - 16/04/1996 - Text adopted by Parliament, 2nd reading

In adopting the report by Mr Frits CASTRICUM (PSE, NL) on the common position of the Council, the EP reiterated some of the political demands voiced at first reading for the further development of the rail networks, with particular reference to the goal of progressively making trans-frontier regional transport, rapid goods transport and, at a later stage, the entire rail transport system interoperable. Finally, it insisted that users must have easy access to the high-speed network through the interoperability of the ticketing, reservation and information systems of the European high-speed railway network.
