## Crisis of the Equitable Life Assurance Society

2006/2199(INI) - 19/06/2007 - Text adopted by Parliament, topical subjects

By adopting, by 602 votes for, 13 against and 64 abstentions, the recommendation based on the report of the Committee of Inquiry into the crisis of the Equitable Life Assurance Society, the European Parliament accepts the position agreed by the committee responsible concerning the report of the Committee of Inquiry.
