EP Rules of Procedure, Rules 15 and 182(1): election of Quaestors and committee bureaux

2006/2287(REG) - 14/12/2006 - Text adopted by Parliament, single reading

The European Parliament adopted a decision on the amendment of Rules 15 and 182(1) of Parliament's Rules of Procedure – election of Quaestors and committee bureaux. The rapporteur was Jo **LEINEN** (PES, Germany.) The report was adopted by 396 votes in favour to 112 against with 57 abstentions.

New clauses state that:

- for the period from January 2007 to July 2009 the Parliament shall elect six Quaestors;
- for the period from January 2007 to July 2009 the committee bureaux shall include four vice-chairmen.
