2007/0294(CNS) - 20/12/2007 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: to undertake a codification of Council Directive 92/102/EEC of 27 November 1992 on the identification and registration of animals.

PROPOSED ACT: Council Directive.

Content: The purpose of this proposal is to undertake a codification of Council Directive 92/102/EEC of 27 November 1992 on the identification and registration of animals. The new Directive will supersede the various acts incorporated in it. This proposal fully preserves the content of the acts being codified and hence does no more than bring them together with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.

2007/0294(CNS) - 15/07/2008 - Final act

PURPOSE: to undertake a codification of Council Directive 92/102/EEC of 27 November 1992 on the identification and registration of animals.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Directive 2008/71/EC on the identification and registration of pigs (Codified version).

CONTENT: the purpose of this Directive is to undertake a codification of Council Directive 92/102/EEC on the identification and registration of animals. This Directive will supersede the various acts incorporated in it. This proposal fully preserves the content of the acts being codified and hence does no more than bring them together with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 28/08/2008.

2007/0294(CNS) - 11/03/2008 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted, by 598 to 9 with 18 abstentions, a legislative resolution under the consultation procedure approving the proposal for a Council directive on the identification and registration of pigs (codified version).

The report was tabled for plenary by Lidia Joanna **GERINGER DE OEDENBERG** (PES, PL) on behalf of the Committee on Legal Affairs.

The proposal was approved as adapted to the recommendations of the Consultative Working Party of the Legal Services of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission.
