Marketing of beet seeds

OBJECTIVE: The proposed consolidated version of Council Directive 66/400/EEC of 14 January 1966 on the marketing of beet seed forms part of a much larger programme of consolidation on the provisions on seeds and propagating material for agriculture, horticulture and forestry. It aims at legislative consolidating the various directives incorporated in it; their content is fully preserved, and they are brought together with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself. This codified text will be used as the basis for the further development of legislation in this field. ?

This amended proposal aims to take account of the legislative changes since the initial proposal for codification of Directive 66/400/EEC on the marketing of beet seed was presented and of the outcome of the Council's work on this proposal.
