Unit of account and conversion rates for the Common Agricultural Policy CAP

OBJECTIVE: the proposal for a Regulation seeks to increase transparency and lend greater economic coherence to import arrangements so as to enable the CAP to be implemented in a consistent way. SUBSTANCE: because the two conversion systems used for amounts relating to imports of agricultural products lead to economic inconsistencies and administrative complications, it is proposed that the conversion rate should be the rate applicable to the amounts levied at the time of import on agricultural or non-agricultural products, when these are determined by an act not falling under the common agricultural policy. ?

Unit of account and conversion rates for the Common Agricultural Policy CAP

The Commission justified its proposal on the grounds that it would simplify the administration of customs procedures by ending the current double system of conversion into national currencies of import costs in the agricultural sector (monthly customs rate and green rate). The President noted that agreement on the Commission proposal was impossible, as most delegations had adopted a negative stance on the matter on the grounds that it would mean a reduction in Community protection with nothing in return. The present double system therefore remained in force (status quo).

As announced in Official Journal C 5 of 9 January 2004, the Commission decided to withdraw this proposal, which had become obsolete.
