Final legislative act with provisions for delegated acts

Sugars intended for human consumption

OBJECTIVE: to simplify certain vertical directives in the food sector, in keeping with the commitment given by the Commission, to simply lay down the essential requirements necessary in order to ensure that the goods concerned can move freely within the internal market.

SUBSTANCE: the proposal for a Council Directive relating to certain sugars recasts Directive 73/437/EEC in order to adapt it to general Community legislation on foodstuffs, notably on labelling, colouring agents and other authorized additives, extraction solvents and methods of analysis. The proposed directive contains provisions on scope, the required contents of labelling and on committology. The annex lists definitions, product names and their composition. The provisions on prepackaged products in Directive 73/437/EEC have been deleted. ?

Sugars intended for human consumption

After having voted to alter the legal basis (Article 100a rather than Article 43 of the EC Treaty) and adopted all the amendments proposed by the Committee on the Environment to the proposal concerning the simplification of the vertical directives on food, the European Parliament, in response to a request from Mr Paul LANNOYE (Greens, B), postponed its vote on the legislative proposals. Mr LANNOYE gave as grounds for his request for postponement the Commission's refusal to accept a large number of Parliament's amendments. ?

Sugars intended for human consumption

Under consultation procedure, the European Parliament adopted the report by Paul A.A.J.G. Lannoye (V,BE), which approves the Commission proposal for a Council directive relating to certain sugars intended for human consumption, subject to amendments adopted at the sitting of 14/01/98, together with a compromise amendment providing that the Commission propose as quickly as possible, and at all events before 01/07/2000, the inclusion in directive 80/232/EEC of a range of nominal weights of the products covered by the proposed directive. ?

Sugars intended for human consumption

PURPOSE : to establish certain rules on sugars for human consumption. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Directive 2001/111/EC relating to certain sugars intended for human consumption. CONTENT : The purpose of this Directive is to establish the rules on manufacturing and

marketing conditions relating to certain sugars intended for human consumption. The Directive applies to sugar products defined in the Annex, but do not apply when those products take the form of icing sugars, candy sugars, sugars in loaf form. Directive 2009/13/EC on labelling applies to the products within the scope of this Directive, with certain exceptions. Member States may not adopt national provisions not provided for by this directive. The measures shall be applied so as to: - authorise the marketing of products in the Annex if they conform to the definitions and rules of this Directive, with effect from 12 July 2003. - prohibit the marketing of products which fail to conform to this Directive, with effect from 12 July 2004. DATE OF TRANSPOSITION : 12/07/03. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 12/01/02.?
