## Partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption

OBJECTIVE: pursuant to the undertakings given by the Community, simplification of certain vertical Directives relating to food to take account only of the essential requirements to be met by the products they cover in order that those products may move freely within the internal market. SUBSTANCE: the proposal for a Council Directive relating to certain preserved milk adapts Directive 76/118/EEC to, in particular, Directives 79/112/EEC on the labelling of foodstuffs, 89/107/EEC on additives, and 92/46/EEC laying down the health rules for production and placing on the market of raw milk, heat-treated milk and milk-based products. The list of special designations in Annex II to the proposal has been reviewed to take account of the designations actually used on the market in the Member States. Finally, the proposal retains the option offered by Directive 76/118/EEC of allowing the Member States to authorize vitaminization of the products covered. ?

## Partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption

After having voted to alter the legal basis (Article 100a rather than Article 43 of the EC Treaty) and adopted all the amendments proposed by the Committee on the Environment to the proposal concerning the simplification of the vertical directives on food, the European Parliament, in response to a request from Mr Paul LANNOYE (Greens, B), postponed its vote on the legislative proposals. Mr LANNOYE gave as grounds for his request for postponement the Commission's refusal to accept a large number of Parliament's amendments. ?

## Partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption

Under consultation procedure, the European Parliament adopted the report by Paul A.A.J.G. Lannoye (V,BE), which approves the Commission proposal for a Council directive relating to certain partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption, subject to amendments adopted at the sitting of 14/01/98, together with a compromise amendment specifying that, with regard to products to which vitamins have been added, consumers must be guaranteed correct information about the composition of the product by providing further information on the label in addition to the list of ingredients.?

## Partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption

PURPOSE : to establish rules on the conditions for the production and marketing of certain preserved milk COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Directive 2001/114/EC relating to certain partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption. CONTENT : This directive lays down definitions and common rules governing the composition, manufacturing specifications and labelling of certain preserved milk, so as to ensure its free movement within the Community. The general food labelling rules laid down in Directive 2001/13/EC apply, subject to certain conditions, which are specific to certain preserved milk. Member States may, subject to Directive 90/496/EEC, authorise the addition of vitamins to the products within the scope of the Directive. Directive 76/118/EEC is repealed with effect from 17 July 2003. DATE OF TRANSPOSITION : 17/07/03. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 12/01/02?
