Convention on cooperation for the protection and sustainable use of the Danube

OBJECTIVE: conclusion, on behalf of the Community, of the Convention on Cooperation for the Protection and Sustainable Use of the Danube. SUBSTANCE: under the proposal for a Council Decision, the Commission recommends the Community and its Member States to conclude the Convention on Cooperation for the Protection and Sustainable Use of the Danube, signed in Sofia on 29 June 1994 by 10 countries, including Germany and Austria, and by the Community itself. The main objective of this Convention is to establish a framework for bi-or multilateral cooperation to protect the aquatic environment, to prevent and control pollution in the Danube and to make for sustainable use of the water of those countries through which the Danube flows. This should help to pave the way for rapid entry into force at international level of rules and regulations to make for pollution prevention, better quality of the environment and water, and viable use of water resources. ?

Convention on cooperation for the protection and sustainable use of the Danube

Committee shares the Commission's view that the rapid entry into force of the convention is highly desirable and it therefore advocates speedy ratification by the EU. This convention is very important for external relations, economic and environmental policy. It is a major contribution to the process of European integration and will help to develop a sustainable economy and to protect natural and ecological resources in the Danube basin.?

Convention on cooperation for the protection and sustainable use of the Danube

OBJECTIVE: to conclude, on behalf of the Community, the Convention on cooperation for the protection and sustainable use of the river Danube. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Decision 97/825/EC. SUBSTANCE: the Council decided to approve, on behalf of the Community, the Convention on cooperation for the protection and sustainable use of the river Danube. The Convention had already been signed on behalf of the Community on 29/06/1994; its purpose is to establish a framework for bilateral or multilateral cooperation to protect the aquatic environment, prevent and control pollution of the Danube and ensure sustainable use of the water resources of the Danubian States. ?
