Control system applicable to the Common Fisheries Policy (amend. Regulation 2847/93/EEC)

OBJECTIVE: to amend Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93, especially as regards the measures needed to ensure compliance with the control system applicable to the common fisheries policy. SUBSTANCE: the proposed amendments extend to the Baltic Title IIa of Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93, and in particular the provisions concerning recording of data on fishing effort in the logbook, the procedures for forwarding the lists of named vessels to the Commission, the collection of data on fishing effort by the Member States and the forwarding of the assembled data to the Commission. The Commission proposes that the Council adopt the proposal by 31/12/1997 at the latest.?

Control system applicable to the Common Fisheries Policy (amend. Regulation 2847/93/EEC)

The Committee endorses the proposal. However, it takes the view that the measures for monitoring the management of fishing effort should be adopted in the EU in collaboration with the IBSFC, in order that they may be applied to all the countries that fish there.?

The Committee on Fisheries adopted the report by Mr EISMA (ELDR, NL) on the control system applicable to the common fisheries policy. It was adopted without amendment and approved the Commission proposal.?

OBJECTIVE: to ensure compliance with the arrangements for managing fishing effort in the Baltic Sea. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Regulation (EC) No 2635/97 amending Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93 establishing a control system applicable to the common fisheries policy. SUBSTANCE: the amendments adopted have the purpose of making Title IIa of Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93 applicable to the Baltic Sea, particularly the provisions concerning the recording of data on fishing effort in the logbook, the procedures for forwarding the lists of named vessels to the Commission, the collection of data on fishing effort by the Member States and the forwarding of the assembled data on fishing effort to the Commission. DATE OF ENTRY INTO FORCE: 07/01/1998. The Regulation is applicable from 01/07/1998. ?
