## Special measures in respect of olive oil (amend. regul. 2262/84/EEC)

---

OBJECTIVE: the draft regulation seeks to extend by one year the EU cofinancing of the four olive oil inspection agencies in order to ensure that they operate properly and to increase their administrative autonomy. CONTENT: the regulation provides for 50% of the agencies actual expenditure for the 1998/1999 marketing year to be met by the general budget of the European Communities. In view of the fact that a draft reform of the COM for olive oil is currently under consideration, the continued EU cofinancing of agencies depends on when this reform will be introduced. The Commission will review the need to continue EU participation in the expenditure of the agencies before 1 October 1998. ?

## Special measures in respect of olive oil (amend. regul. 2262/84/EEC)

OBJECTIVE: to extend by one year Community co-financing of the four olive oil inspection agencies to ensure that they operate properly and increase their administrative autonomy. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Regulation (EC) No 2599/97 amending Regulation (EEC) No 2262/84 laying down special measures in respect of olive oil. SUBSTANCE: the amendment extends for one additional year the arrangement whereby the Community covers 50% of the national agencies' expenditure on inspection work to verify compliance with the rules on olive oil. Before 01/01/1998, the Commission is to ascertain whether it is necessary to continue the Community's participation in the expenditure of the agencies and will, if appropriate, submit a proposal to the Council. The Italian and German delegations voted against the proposal. DATE OF ENTRY INTO FORCE: 30/12/1997. ?
