RTD 5th framework programme 1998-2002: research, development, demonstration, direct actions by the JRC

OBJECTIVE: to adopt a specific programme for research and technological development, including demonstration, to be carried out by means of direct actions by the Joint Research Centre (1998 to 2002). SUBSTANCE: with a view to the implementation of the fifth framework programme of R&TD, the Commission proposes adopting a specific programme to be carried out by means of actions by the Joint Research Centre for the period 1998-2002. The amount deemed necessary for the implementation of the specific programme is ECU 815 m (ECU 200 m for 1998-1999; ECU 615 m for 2000-2002). The three main themes of the programme are as follows: a) serving the citizen: the objective is to support a policy intended to protect members of the public as individuals (measures to guarantee the quality of foodstuffs, beverages and consumer goods; protecting tax-payers against fraud; health care; reliable information; protecting the public against man-made and natural hazards); b) enhancing sustainability: analysing the environmental impact of various political options, bolstering anti-fraud measures under the agricultural and fisheries policies; supporting international efforts to combat global climate change; studying the development of European ecosystems and ways of preserving them; c) underpinning European competitiveness: measures to promote the transfer of know-how and research results from the scientific community to industrial users (e.g. remote sensing and advanced materials).?

RTD 5th framework programme 1998-2002: research, development, demonstration, direct actions by the JRC

Following the successful conclusion of the conciliation procedure between the Parliament and the Council, the Parliament adopted its opinion on the specific programme for RTD, including demonstration, to be carried out by means of direct actions by the JRC (1998-2002) for the

European Community. The Parliament's Rapporteur was E. McNALLY (UK, PES). The overall budget will be 739 million ECU. This will be broken down into 189 million for the period 1998/88, and 550 million for the 2000/02 period. According to the amendments approved, the scope of this proposal would be extended to cover, among other things, the harmonisation of standards for organic foods and for food animal husbandry, and insulating and other energy efficient materials and devices. Another amendment concerned the representation of the Parliament on the board of the JRC.?

PURPOSE: to adopt a specific programme for research and technological development, including demonstration, to be carried out by means of direct actions for the European Community (1998 to 2002) by the Joint Research Centre (JRC). COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council decision 1999/174/EC. CONTENT: in accordance with the 5th framework programme for RTD, the amount deemed necessary for the execution of direct actions by the JRC under this programme is EURO 739 million (EURO 189 million for the period 1998 to 1999 and EURO 550 million for the period 2000 to 2002). Indicative breakdown (in millions of Euros): - serving the citizen (consumer protection, medical and health applications, benefiting from the information society and safety of the citizen): 292 - enhancing sustainability (integration of environmental protection in other Community policies, pollution, global change, energy and transport, agriculture, rural development and fisheries): 321 - underpinning European competitiveness (employment, technology and industrial competitiveness, normative support to the international trading system, innovation and technology transfer, enlargement, pre-accession and international cooperation): 126.?
