## Quality wines from production areas : special disposals

---

OBJECTIVE: to amend Regulation (EEC) No 823/87 to allow Member States to make bottling in the specified region of production compulsory for certain quality wines psr (produced in specified regions). SUBSTANCE: the purpose of the proposal for a Regulation is to allow Member States to make bottling in the specified region of production compulsory for certain quality wines psr under certain objective conditions: - where bottling within the region of production gives the wine special characteristics or constitutes an important factor in preserving the special characteristics acquired; - where the overwhelming majority of the operators in the sector are in favour of such an obligation regarding bottling. This measure is based on considerations of a legal nature; the introduction of the obligation regarding bottling should form part of the requirements governing the designation of origin concerned while the reputation of the wine and the guarantee regarding origin could be protected on the grounds of industrial and commercial property rights. The measure is also based on arguments relating to the quality of the wine. ?

This proposal, in accordance with Article 185 of the European Parliament's Rules of Procedure, was deemed to have lapsed. It will be the subject of consideration by the new Parliament (5th legislature).?

## Quality wines from production areas : special disposals

The Directorates General or responsible departments have asked for this proposal to be withdrawn. The reasons are indicated as follows: A) for objective reasons (change of de facto situation, objectives already achieved by other means, etc) B) because the Commission has now adopted another approach : - the proposal is replaced implicitly, - a new proposal is in preparation, - no planned replacement.?
