Research RTD, 5th EC framework-programme 1998-2002: Specific programme "human research potential, socio-economic knowledge base"

OBJECTIVE: to adopt a specific programme for research, technological development and demonstration on 'Improving the human research potential and the socio-economic knowledge base' (1998 to 2002). SUBSTANCE: with a view to the implementation of the fifth framework programme of R&TD, the Commission proposes adopting a specific programme on 'improving the human research potential and the socio-economic knowledge base' for the period 1998-2002. The amount deemed necessary for the implementation of the specific programme is ECU 1402 m (ECU 288.5 m for 1998-1999; ECU 1113.5 m for 2000-2002). The general outlines of the programme are as follows: a) actions specific to the horizontal programme: - supporting training and mobility of researchers: research training networks, Marie Curie fellowships; -

improving access to research infrastructure: transnational access to major research infrastructure; infrastructure cooperation networks; - promoting scientific and technological excellence: high-level scientific conferences; distinctions for high-level research work; raising public awareness; b) a key action, 'improving the socio-economic knowledge base': - research into societal trends and structural changes; - research into interdependence and integration between technology, society and employment; - governance and citizenship management systems; - prospective research into new development models fostering growth and employment; c) support for the development of scientific and technology policies in Europe: - strategic analysis of specific political issues; - common base of science, technology and innovation indicators. ?

Research RTD, 5th EC framework-programme 1998-2002: Specific programme "human research potential, socio-economic knowledge base"

The Committee on Research, Technological Development and Energy has adopted the report of Mr. Lange (PES, D) on the specific programme about "human potential" and implementing the 5th framework programme. The Committee took on board a Commission proposal for the distribution of the amount foreseen in two periods: one for 1999 (293) and another for 2000-2002 (987). The EP and the Council could accept an overall amount for EC and Euratom research activities of Ecu 14.960 million, of which Ecu 13.700m for the EC programme and Ecu 1.260m for the Euratom programme. ?

Following the successful conclusion of the conciliation procedure between the Parliament and the Council regarding the Fifth Framework Programme, the Parliament approved its opinion on the specific RTD programme 'improving the human research potential and the socio-economic knowledge base' (1998-2002), drafted by Mr. LANGE (D, PES). The overall budget will be 1280 million ECU. 293 million will be available for the 1998/99 period and 987 million for the 2000/02 period. Other amendments adopted related to the importance of training and the close monitoring of its results. ?

PURPOSE: to adopt a specific programme for research, technological development and demonstration on improving the human research potential and the socioeconomic knowledge base (1998 to 2002). COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council decision 1999/173/EC. CONTENT: in accordance with the 5th framework programme for RTD, the amount deemed necessary for carrying out the specific programme is EURO 1,280 million (EURO 293 million for the period 1998 to 1999 and EURO 987 million for the period 2000 to 2002). Indicative breakdown (in millions of Euros): - supporting training and mobility of researchers: 858 - enhancing access to research infrastructures: 182 - promoting scientific and technological excellence: 50 - key action: improving the socioeconomic knowledge base: 165 - support for the development of scientific and technology policies in Europe: 25. ?
