OBJECTIVE: as part of the pre-accession strategy, the opening of certain Community programmes in the field of health and social policy to Hungary for the period 1998 to 2000. SUBSTANCE: the proposal for a decision of the EC-Hungary Association Council establishes the conditions and arrangements for the participation of this country in several Community programmes in the field of health and social policy: health promotion, combating cancer, the prevention of aids and other communicable diseases, drug dependence and the equal opportunities programme.
