#### Health and social policy: participation of Romania in the Community programmes

OBJECTIVE: as part of the pre-accession strategy, the opening of certain Community programmes in the field of health and social policy to Romania (combating cancer and Aids prevention) for the period 1998 to 2000. SUBSTANCE: the proposal for a decision of the EC-Romania Association Council establishes the conditions and arrangements for the participation of this country in several Community programmes in the field of health and social policy: the programme on health promotion, the programme on combating cancer, the prevention of Aids and other communicable diseases, drug dependence and the equal opportunities programme. In particular Romania will: - take part in all the activities of these programmes on the same terms as the Member States and in accordance with the objectives, criteria and procedures laid down by these programmes; - apply as far as possible the same conditions and arrangements for submission, assessment and selection of applications as those which apply in the Member States; - provide for a minimum number of partners from the Member States for all the proposed transnational activities and projects; - make a financial contribution to the Community's budget by virtue of its participation in these various programmes. This contribution will cover the financial aid granted to Romanian participants in relation to their participation in the programmes and the supplementary costs of an administrative nature related to the management of the programmes by the Commission. This contribution will vary depending on the programme and is paid annually. The Community will pay part of this contribution by taking the sums needed from the annual funding for Phare/Romania. The Phare contribution will not however cover the equivalent of the administrative sums relating to the management of the programmes by the Commission, which will remain entirely the responsibility of the Romanian national budget. In total this financial contribution will amount to ECU 1 404 513 for the three years under consideration (of which ECU 656 313 under Phare). Romania will be associated with the monitoring of its participation in the cultural programmes in preparation for the Community decision-making process on accession (in particular by participation in the coordination meetings prior to the meetings of the programme committees and by being informed about the results). The participation of Romania will be valid for the duration of the programmes (i.e. until 31 December 2000). ?

### Health and social policy: participation of Romania in the Community programmes

PURPOSE: within the framework of the pre-accession strategy, to open certain Community programmes in the field of health and social policy to Romania for the years 1998-2000. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council decision 1999/110/EC. CONTENT: this decision (6/98) of the EC/Romania Association Council of 03/12/98 lays down the conditions and requirments for this country's participation in a number of Community programmes in the field of health and social policy: Health promotion, Combatting cancer, Prevention of AIDS and other communicable diseases, Drug dependence and Equal opportunities for men and women. In particular, Romania will: - participate in all of the relevant operations in the same capacity as the Member States and in accordance with the objectives, criteria and procedures established by those programmes; - as far as possible, apply the same conditions and requirements for the presentation, assessment and selection of applications as those applied by the Member States; - be required to include a minimum number of partners from the Member States in all of the transnational projects and activities it proposes; - pay a financial contribution to the Community budget to cover the costs of its participation in these various programmes. This contribution will cover both financial support from the programmes to Romanian participants and supplementary administrative costs related to the management of the programmes by the Commission stemming from Romania's participation. The contribution varies according to the programme and is made annually. Subject to regular PHARE programming procedures, some of this contribution wil come from Romania's PHARE allocation. This does not include the supplementary administrative costs which will be borne entirely by Romania's national budget. In total, this financial contribution amounts to ECU 1,404,513 for the 3 years in question (of which ECU 656,313 comes from PHARE). Romania will be involved in the monitoring of its participation in the programmes concerned with a

view to preparing for the Community decision-making process in the context of accession (in particular by being invited to coordination meetings prior to the regular meetings of the programme committees and being kept informed of the results of the committees' meetings). Romania's partipation is valid for the duration of the programmes (until 31/12/2000). ENTRY INTO FORCE: 01/01/1999.?
