Research RTD EC/Euratom 5th framework programme 1998-2002: association of Czech republic

PURPOSE: in the context of the pre-accession strategy, the opening of the Fifth RTD Framework Programme and the EURATOM Framework Programme to the Czech Republic for the period 1998-2002. CONTENT: this proposal for a Council Decision of the EC-Czech Republic Association Council adopting the terms and conditions for the participation of the Czech Republic in Community programmes in the fields of research, technological development and demonstration (1998-2002), and in EURATOM programmes for research and training activities (1998-2002). It is provided for that research entities established in the Czech Republic (universities, research organisations, industrial companies, including SMEs, or natural persons) may participate in EU programmes under the same conditions as EU entities. The proposal specifies the forms that this participation may take, as well as the implications as regards ownership, exploitation and dissemination of information and intellectual property arising from such participation. The financial contribution of the Czech Republic deriving from participation in the implementation of the specific programmes shall be established in proportion to, and in addition to, the amount available each year in the general EU budget for commitment appropriations to meet the Commission's financial obligations stemming from work to be carried out in the forms necessary for the implementation, management and operation of these programmes. The proportionality factor governing the contribution of the Czech Republic shall be obtained by establishing the ratio between the GDP of the Czech Republic, at market prices, and the sum of the GDPs, at market prices, of the EU Member States and the Czech Republic. The financial statement annexed to the proposal fixes the total contribution of the Czech Republic for the 5 years of the Framework Programmes at 95.78 million euros (it should be noted that the Czech Republic will be able to use some Phare resources to pay this contribution). Expenditures for Community management of programmes are estimated at 0.25 million euros/year. Procedures are laid down to enable Czech representives to participate in the work of the committees of the various programmes. Provisions are also made to associate this country with any future framework programme.?

PURPOSE: the opening up of the Fifth Framework Programme in the field of research and technological development and of the Fifth EURATOM Framework Programme to the Czech Republic for the period 1998-2002. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Decision 1999/653/EC. CONTENT: this Decision no 2/1999 of the EU-Czech Republic Association Council sets the terms and conditions for the participation of the Czech Republic in the specific programmes of the Fifth Framework Programme and of the Fifth EURATOM Programme. It is foreseen that the Czech research bodies (universities, research centres, industrial companies, ...) will participate in all the planned programmes under the same conditions as the Community bodies. The Decision specifies the ways in which this participation may take place, as well as the intellectual property and confidentiality of information arising from carrying out joint research. There are also indications provided on the subject of the Czech Republic's financial contributions to the Community budget with regard to its participation in these various programmes. These will be fixed on the basis of the ratio of the gross domestic product of the Czech Republic to the sum of the gross domestic product of the Member States and that of the Czech Republic, and in addition to the supplementary administrative costs attributable to the management of the programmes by the Commission. Very precise rules govern the financial participation of this country in the planned programmes. Measures are also laid down to enable Czech representatives to participate in the work of the various programme committees,

as well as to associate this country with all the subsequent framework programmes. ENTRY INTO FORCE: 01.08.1999. The Decision is valid for the duration of the fifth framework programme (that is, until 2002).?
