# Research RTD, 5th framework-programme 1998-2002: association of Cyprus

PURPOSE: in the context of the pre-accession strategy, the association of Cyprus with the actions of the Fifth RTD Framework Programme for the period 1998-2002. CONTENT: this proposal for an additional protocol to the EC-Cyprus Association Agreement (concluded in 1973) sets down the terms and conditions for the participation of Cyprus in Community programmes in the fields of research, technological development and demonstration (1998-2002). It is provided for that research entities established in Cyprus (universities, research organisations, industrial companies, including SMEs, or natural persons) may participate in EU programmes under the same conditions as EU entities. The draft protocol specifies the forms that this participation may take, as well as the implications as regards ownership, exploitation and dissemination of information and intellectual property arising from such participation. Guidelines are also laid down in regard to the financial contribution of Cyprus to the EU budget with respect to its participation in the various programmes. This contribution shall be established using the ratio between the GDP of Cyprus, at market prices, and the sum of the GDPs, at market prices, of the EU Member States and Cyprus, as well as additional administrative costs imputable to the management of the programmes by the Commission. The financial statement annexed to the proposed protocol fixes the total contribution of Cyprus for the 5 years of the Framework Programme at 14.38 million euros. Expenditures for Community management of programmes are estimated at 0.25 million euros/year. Procedures are laid down to enable Cypriot representives to participate in the work of the committees of the various programmes. The protocol will be concluded for the period of the duration of the Fifth Framework Programme (1998-2002).?

PURPOSE: in the context of the pre-accession strategy, to associate Cyprus with the European Community's fifth framework programme for research, technological development and demonstration activities (1998-2002). COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Decision 460/1999/EC on concluding the Additional Protocol to the EEC/Cyprus Association Agreement to associate Cyprus with the fifth framework programme of the European Community for research, technological development and demonstration activities (1998-2002). CONTENT: this Additional Protocol to the EEC/Cyprus Association Agreement sets out the terms and conditions of the participation of this country in the specific programmes of the fifth framework programme for RTD. It is intended that Cypriot research bodies (universities, research centres, industrial enterprises,...) may participate in all the programmes foreseen and under the same conditions as Community bodies. The protocol specifies the forms of

organisation that will be able to participate, as well as the implications in terms of intellectual property and confidentiality of information that follow on from carrying out joint research. Indications are also provided regarding the financial contribution of Cyprus to the Community budget with respect to its participation in these various programmes. This will be set in proportion to the country's GDP in relation to the total GDP of the Member States and that of Cyprus and by complementing the additional administration costs attributable to the management of programmes by the Commission. In addition, very precise rules govern the financial participation of this country in the planned programmes. The conditions are provided in order to allow Cypriot representatives the possibility to participate in the works of the Committee of these various programmes. ENTRY INTO FORCE: the protocol enters into force the 20.05.1999 and will be valid for the duration of the fifth framework programme (that is until 2002).?
