EC Staff Regulations of officials: equal treatment for freelance interpreters

OBJECTIVE: to amend the Staff Regulations for European officials in order to re-establish the equal treatment of free-lance interpreters within the European Institutions. CONTENT: The proposal seeks to remedy the considerable inequality that exists in the treatment of free-lance interpreters employed regularly by the Institutions other than the Parliament and the Parliament's free-lance interpreters (employed as auxiliary staff during sessions) given that the work carried out by both is equivalent. As a consequence, Commission is proposing to modify the system applicable to other agents in the Staff Regulations by extending the principle currently applicable to free-lance interpreters of the Parliament to free-lance interpreters in other Institutions and Community bodies. The conference interpreters will all be employed as auxiliary agents once the amending Regulation is adopted by the Council.?

PURPOSE: The Regulation is amended to the effect that the same terms and conditions of employment applied to conference interpreters engaged by the European Parliament shall apply to auxiliary staff engaged by the Commission as conference interpreters on behalf of the Community institutions and bodies.
