EEA agreement: amending annex I (veterinary and phytosanitary matters, establishments approved)

PURPOSE: amendment of Annex I (Veterinary and Phytosanitary Matters) to the EEA Agreement. CONTENT: Protocol 1 to the EEA Agreement lays down the rules concerning the exchange of information between the Community and the EFTA States. However, in the field of veterinary matters, there is a need for a more rapid procedure for communicating the lists of establishments approved for the purpose of the Agreement. It is for the EEA Joint Committee to take decisions to amend the EEA Agreement, as laid down in Article 98 of the Agreement. The EEA Joint Committee should therefore adopt the attached decision to amend Annex I to the EEA Agreement. Article 1(3)(a) of Council Regulation 2894/94/EC concerning arrangements for implementing the EEA Agreement envisages that the Council establishes the Community position for such decisions.?
