Agriculture, Community aid: integrated administration and control system IACS (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3508/92)

PURPOSE : to amend Regulation 3508/92/EEC establishing an integrated administration and control system for certain Community aid schemes. **CONTENT :** The amendments proposed are due to the fact that the reform of the common agricultural policy requires adjustments to be made to the integrated administration and control system (IACS). The provisions include the following: - Each Member State must set up an IACS for the application of other Community area aid schemes. The may extend the integrated system to other schemes. - An identification system for agricultural parcels will be established, using computerised geographical information system techniques. - There are detailed measures on area aid application. - Measures for the implementation of the above-numbered Regulation are management measures and should be adopted by use of the management procedure provided for in Article 4 of Council Decision 1999/468/EC of 28 JUNE 1999. The Regulation is amended accordingly.?

Agriculture, Community aid: integrated administration and control system IACS (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3508/92)

The committee adopted the report (consultation procedure) by Paulo CASACA (PES, P) approving, subject to a number of amendments, the Commission proposal to amend the regulation establishing an integrated administration and control system (IACS) for certain Community aid schemes. The committee drew attention to the delays by some Member States in setting up the IACS and also proposed that the regulation's scope be broadened to include tobacco, olive oil, flax and hemp (areas where fraud and irregularities have frequently occurred). The

committee also called for the Commission to provide Member States with computerised administrative information, for use under the integrated system, on EAGGF (Guarantee Section) payments. The Commission is currently required to supply such information only in connection with the clearing of accounts. ?

Agriculture, Community aid: integrated administration and control system IACS (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3508/92)

The European Parliament adopted the resolution drafted by Paulo CASACA (PES, Portugal) amending the Commission proposal establishing IACS for certain Community aid schemes. The recitals reflect that not all Member States have not made substantial progress in the establishment of the IACS. The Regulation's scope is extended to include oils and fats, tobacco, and flax and hemp. In addition, for each individual operation involving EAGGF payments and receipts, Member States shall forward annually to the Commission computer records marked 'X' 'A' or 'B' by budget item in Annex 1 of Regulation 2390/1999/EC.?

Agriculture, Community aid: integrated administration and control system IACS (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3508/92)

PURPOSE : to amend Regulation 3508/92/EEC establishing an integrated administration and control system for certain Community aid schemes. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Regulation 1593/2000/EC amending Regulation 3508/92/EEC establishing an integrated administration and control system for certain Community aid schemes. CONTENT : the purpose of this Regulation is to adjust the Integrated Administration and Control System (IACS), established by Regulation 3508/92/EEC, to the new Community aid schemes resulting from the 1992 CAP reform, and to extend the scope of the system whenever possible to other Community aid schemes in view of its proven effectiveness both for applying aid schemes and for monitoring irregularities. It should be noted that Member States are to design their own systems, compatible with the essential elements of the integrated administration and control of other Community aid schemes. The proposed system includes certain new technical arrangements such as geographical information systems and digital orthophotography. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 28/07/2000.?
