## Ombudsman: regulations and general conditions of performance of duties

The committee adopted the report by Teresa ALMEIDA GARRETT (EPP-ED, P) proposing that Articles 12 and 16 of the regulations governing the performance of the Ombudsman's duties be deleted (these articles refer to the Ombudsman's budget as being annexed to Parliament's budget). This change in the regulations was needed because, at Parliament's request, Council had amended the Financial Regulation so as to create a specific section for the Ombudsman within the general EU budget. The purpose of the report was therefore to bring the regulations governing the performance of the Ombudsman's duties into line with the amendment made to the Financial Regulation.?

### Ombudsman: regulations and general conditions of performance of duties

The European Parliament voted by 131 to 0 with 4 abstentions to endorse the resolution drafted by Mrs Teresa ALMEIDA GARRETT (EPP/ED, P) that amends current legislation on the Ombudsman's budget. The changes will mean that there will be a separate section in the general budget of the Communities for the budget of the Ombudsman rather than incorporated in an annex to Parliament's budget, as is currently the case.?

### Ombudsman: regulations and general conditions of performance of duties

This documents sets out the Commission's opinion on the resolution of 17 November 2000 of the European Parliament concerning the European Ombudsman. In its opinion, the Commission is of the same view as the European Parliament and believes that Articles 12 and 16 of the Decision of the European Parliament 94/262/ECSC, EC, Euratom of 9 March 1994 (OJ L 113, 4 may 1994, p. 15) concerning the regulations and the general conditions of performance of the Ombudsman's duties, should be deleted in conformity with the terms of the European Parliament's resolution.

#### Ombudsman: regulations and general conditions of performance of duties

PURPOSE: to amend provisions relating to the budget of the Ombudsman. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Decision 262/2002/EC, ECSC, Euratom of the European Parliament amending Decision 94/262/ECSC, EC, Euratom on the regulations and general conditions governing the performance of the Ombudsman's duties. CONTENT: By the terms of the Financial Regulation of 21 December 1977, the Ombudsman is treated as an institution for the purposes of the general budget of the Communities. Council Regulation 2673/1999 amending the Financial Regulation created a specific section for the Ombudsman in the general budget of the European Union. This Decision amends the European Parliament Decision 262/1994, and specifically Articles 12 and 16, since they provide for the budget of the Ombudsman to be placed in an annex to Section I (Parliament) of the general budget of the Communities.
