Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

PURPOSE : to amend the Council Directives in force governing maritime safety, protection of the marine environment and shipboard living and working conditions (refer equally to COD/2000/0236). CONTENT : this proposal for a directive aims to amend the existing directives in the field of maritime safety in order to take account of the establishment of the committee on safe seas and to facilitate their subsequent updating. ?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

The committee adopted the report by Emmanouil BAKOPOULOS (PES, GR) broadly approving the proposal under the codecision procedure (1st reading) subject to a number of amendments. It felt that the proposal should be welcomed as an attempt at rational organisation and centralisation of the tasks relating to the Union's maritime safety policy, as well as a more general contribution towards improving the monitoring of the maritime safety aspects of Community and international law. The committee did, however, adopt a few amendments aimed at safeguarding Parliament's rights to take part in the regulatory procedure. It also recommended that the new body be called the "Committee on Safe Seas and the Prevention of Pollution by Ships". Lastly, it adopted an amendment which sought to clarify the text by stipulating that the risk of lowering standards should be certified by the Commission or a Member State. ?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

The European Parliament endorsed the report by Mr Emmanouil BAKOPOULOS (EUL/NGL, GR) on maritime safety. Amendments were adopted requesting that the new name of the Committee on Safe Seas be 'Committee on Safe Seas and the Prevention of Pollution from Ships'.?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

The Commission broadly welcomes the proposed amendments presented to the Commission by Parliament following its first reading. The Commission agrees to adopt the text in order to make it consistent with other pertinent Community legislation in this field.?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

Following the same approach as in the common position concerning the Regulation (refer to COD/2000/0236), the Council has modified the description of the scope of the directives covered by the proposal to include the prevention of pollution from ships. It shares, however, the view expressed, by the Commission that the protection of the marine environment is covered by the environmental legislation and that reference to this area should there not be included. The Common position includes a few other modifications to the Commission proposals. The description of purpose of the Directive (Article 1) has been slightly modified in order to clarify the reference to the update of Community legislation and to align its wording with the corresponding provision in the Regulation. Finally, some purely technical amendments have been introduced in order to take account of the most recent Community maritime legislation.?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

The Commission welcomes and accepts the Council's common position noting that it incorporates most of its and the Parliament's amendments tabled at first reading.?

The committee adopted the report by Emmanouil BAKOPOULOS (EUL/NGL, GR) approving the common position without amendment under the second reading of the codecision procedure.?

The European Parliament adopted the resolution drafted by Emmanouil BAKAPOULOS (EUL/NGL, Greece) and approved the Council's common position.?

Maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships

PURPOSE : to improve the implementation of Community legislation on maritime safety, the prevention of pollution from ships and shipboard living and working conditions. **COMMUNITY MEASURE** : Directive 2002/84/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council amending the Directives on maritime safety and the prevention of pollution from ships. **CONTENT** : this Directive is closely linked to Regulation 2099/2002/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 November 2002, establishing a Committee on Safe Seas and the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (COSS) centralises the tasks of the committees established under the pertinent Community legislation on maritime safety, the prevention of safety, prevention of pollution from ships and shipboard living and working conditions. The Regulation and the Directive have the same objectives. However, more specifically, the purpose of this Directive is to improve the implementation of Community legislation on maritime safety, the prevention of pollution from ships and shipboard living and working conditions: - by making reference to the COSS; - by accelerating the update and facilitating the amendment of such legislation in the light of developments in the international instruments applicable in the field of maritime safety, prevention of pollution from ships and shipboard living and working conditions, pursuant to Regulation 2099/2002/EC. **ENTRY INTO FORCE** : 29/11/2002. **TRANSPOSITION** : 23/11/2003.?
