Europol: adjusting the basic salaries and allowances applicable to staff. Initiative Sweden

PURPOSE : to present the Initiative of the Kingdom of Sweden with a view to the adoption of a Council Decision adjusting the basic salaries and allowances applicable to Europol staff. CONTENT : following the review of remuneration of officials of Europol by the Management Board, taking into account the changes of the cost of living in the Hague, as well as the changes in salaries in the public service in the Member States and the needs of recruitment for Europol, it is proposed that an increase of 3,7% of remuneration for the period between 1 July 1999 and 1 July 2000 is justified. ?

PURPOSE : to adjust the basic salaries and allowances applicable to Europol staff. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Decision adjusting the basic salaries and allowances applicable to Europol staff. CONTENT : the Swedish Initiative intends to adjust the basic salaries and allowances applicable to Europol staff as well as the changes in salary and remunerations which have been paid taking account of the changes in the review of the level of remunerations of the Europol staff by the Europol Management Board. To recall, Europol's Management Board regularly reviews the level of remunerations in order to take into account the cost of living in the Hague (Netherlands, Europol's Head Quarters) as well as changes in salaries in the public service in the Member States and the needs of recruitment for Europol. The review justifies an increase of 3,7% of remuneration for the period between 01.07.1999 and 01.07.2000. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 16 March 2001. The decision takes effect from 1 July 1999.
