Forests: protection against atmospheric pollution, extension to 2002 (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3528/86)

PURPOSE: To extend Community Regulation on the protection of forests against atmospheric pollution by one year. **CONTENT:** The 1986 Regulation on the protection of the Community's forest against atmospheric pollution was set to expire on 31 December 2001. Under conditions set out in Regulation 3528/86 the Commission is responsible for presenting an updated draft Regulation prior to its expiry. Preparation of the revised proposal however is still under way and the Commission is not, as yet, in a position to present a revised Regulation to the European Parliament and Council. Transitional measures are therefore needed to extend the Regulation for a further year so that the scheme can continue in 2002. The financial allocation for the implementation of the scheme shall be EUR 41.75 million for the period 1997 to 2002.?

Forests: protection against atmospheric pollution, extension to 2002 (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3528/86)

The European Parliament, using its procedure without debate, adopted the report drafted by Encarcion Redondo Jimenez (EPP/ED, Spain) on the protection of forests against atmospheric pollution. (Please refer to the document dated 19/02/02.) The financial allocation was raised to EUR 42.6 million for the period 1997 to 2002.?

Forests: protection against atmospheric pollution, extension to 2002 (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3528/86)

PURPOSE : to extend Community Regulation on the protection of forests against atmospheric pollution by one year. **COMMUNITY MEASURE**

: Regulation 804/2002/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Council Regulation 3528/86/EEC on the protection of the Community's forests against atmospheric pollution. CONTENT : the 1986 Regulation on the protection of the Community's forest against atmospheric pollution expired on 31 December 2001. Under conditions set out in Regulation 3528/86, the Commission is responsible for presenting an updated draft Regulation prior to its expiry. Preparation of the revised proposal however is still under way and the Commission is not, as yet, in a position to present a revised Regulation to the European Parliament and Council. Transitional measures are therefore needed to extend the Regulation for a further year so that the scheme can continue in 2002. The scheme shall run for 16 years from 1 January 1987. The financial allocation for the implementation of the scheme shall be EUR 42,6 million for the period 1997 to 2002. Annual appropriations shall be authorised by the budgetary authority within the limits of the financial perspective. Before 30 June 2002, the Commission shall submit to the European Parliament and to the council a report on the application of this Regulation and a proposal for revision covering in particular the ecological, economic and social aspects (qualitative assessment) and the results of a cost-benefit analysis (quantitative assessment).
ENTRY INTO FORCE : 17 May 2002.?
