Court of Justice, Statute: amending article 20 on preliminary-ruling proceedings

PURPOSE : to present a draft Council Decision which aims to amend Article 20 of the Protocol on the EC Statute of the Court of Justice. CONTENT : the proposed amendment of Article 20 of the Statute is designed to provide for the participation of non-Member States in preliminary-ruling proceedings before the Court of Justice where an agreement relating to a specific subject-matter, concluded by the Council with one or more non-Member States, provides that those States are to be entitled to submit statements of case or written observations where a court or tribunal of a Member State refers to the Court for a preliminary ruling a question falling within the scope of the agreement. The amendment has become necessary as a result of the entry into force of the Agreement concluded on 18 May 1999 by the Council of the European Union and the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the association of those States with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis. Article 9(2) of the Agreement provides that, subject to the adoption of the necessary modifications of the Statute of the Court of Justice, Iceland and Norway are to entitled to submit statements of case or written observations to the Court in cases where a question has been referred to it by a court of tribunal of a Member State for a preliminary ruling concerning the interpretation of any provision of the Schengen acquis falling within the scope of the Agreement.?

Court of Justice, Statute: amending article 20 on preliminary-ruling proceedings

The Commission presents an opinion of the proposal for a Decision which aims to amend Article 20 of the Protocol on the EC Statute of the Court of Justice. In its opinion, the Commission reveals that the proposed amendment is necessary as a result of the entry into force of the agreement concluded by the Council in 1999 with the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the association of those States to the implementation, the application and the development of the Schengen acquis (OJ L 176 of 10 July 1999, p.36) of which Article 9, paragraph 2, provides for the possibility for these two third countries to participate in the preliminary rulings introduced before the Court. A similar amendment was made to Article 20 of the Statute of the Court in order to allow the States participating in the agreement on the European Economic Area as well as EFTA Surveillance Authority to participate in the preliminary rulings before the Court of Justice. According to the Commission, the proposed formulation shall prevent the amending of Article 20 of the Statute, at the time of the entry into force of any new agreement foreseeing the participation of other third countries in preliminary rulings. Consequently, the Commission agrees with the proposed text by the Court of Justice.?

Court of Justice, Statute: amending article 20 on preliminary-ruling proceedings

PURPOSE : to amend Article 20 of the Protocol on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Communities. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Decision 2002/653/EC amending the Protocol on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Communities. CONTENT : in accordance with the second paragraph of Article 245 of the EC Treaty, the Council has decided to amend the protocol on the statute of the Court of Justice in order for provisions to be made for participation by non-member States in preliminary-ruling proceedings before the Court of Justice in the event that an agreement relating to a specific subject matter, concluded by the Council with one or more non-member States. It provides that those States are to be entitled to submit statements of case or written observations where a court or tribunal of a member State refers to the Court of Justice for a preliminary ruling a question falling within the scope of the agreement. The amendment is necessary as a result of the entry into force of the agreement concluded by the Council in 1999 with the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway concerning the association of those States to the implementation, the application and the development of the Schengen acquis.
