## European Food Safety Authority: appointment of 14 members of the Management Board

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**PURPOSE** : to present the list of possible candidates nominated as Members of the European Food Safety Agency. This list is to be submitted to the Council and the European Parliament. **CONTENT** : this document proposes a list of 30 candidates presented by the Commission to the European Parliament and the Council with a view to appointing 14 definitive Members to the European Food Safety Agency. The list provides names of people who have required experience in consumer organisations and interest groups working in this sector. ?

## European Food Safety Authority: appointment of 14 members of the Management Board

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**PURPOSE** : to appoint the members of the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority. **COMMUNITY MEASURE** : Council Decision 2002/0727 appointing the members of the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority. **CONTENT** : it is vital to ensure the independence, high scientific quality, transparency and efficiency of the European Food Safety Authority. Cooperation with Member States is also indispensable. The candidatures have been examined on the basis of the documentation provided by the Commission and in the light of the views expressed by the European Parliament with the aim of securing the highest standard of competence, a broad range of relevant expertise, for instance in management and in public administration, and the broadest possible geographic distribution within the Union. Four of the members should have a background in organisations representing consumers and other interests in the food chain. The members of the Management Board should generally be appointed for a period of four years; however, for the first appointment of the Board half of the members should be appointed for a period of six years. The following shall be appointed members of the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority for the period from 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2008: - Giorgio Calabrese - Catherine Geslain-Laneelle - Matthias Ludwig Horst - Deirdre Hutton - Joao Pedro Machado - PirkkoMarjatta Raunemaa - Patrick Gerard Wall. The following shall be appointed members of the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority for the period from 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2006: - Angeliki Assimakopoulou - Ernst Bobek - Carlos Escribano Mora - Peter Gaemelke - Bart Sangster - Stuart Alexander Slorach - Roland Vaxelaire.
