Fruit and vegetables, producer organisations: starting date of the transitional period (rectif. Regulation (EC) No 2200/96)

PURPOSE : to correct the starting date for the transitional period in Regulation 2200/96/EC. CONTENT : Council Regulation 2200/96 on the common organisation of the market in fruit and vegetables gave producer organisations a period of two to five years to be recognised, starting with the date of entry into force of the Regulation, 21/11/96. This date is the result of an error. The beginning date for the transitional periods should have been the date of application of the Regulation (01/01/97) and not the date of entry into force. This proposal rectifies that error, so that the starting date for the transitional periods of two to five years begins on 01/01/97.?

The European Parliament, using its simplified procedure, adopted the resolution drafted by Joseph DAUL (EPP-ED, France) and approved the Commission's proposals without amendment.?

Fruit and vegetables, producer organisations: starting date of the transitional period (rectif. Regulation (EC) No 2200/96)

PURPOSE : to rectify Regulation 2200/96/EC relating to the starting date of the transitional period for the recognition of producer organisations. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Regulation 1881/2002/EC. CONTENT : pursuant to Article 13(1) of Council Regulation 2200/96/EC, a transitional period of 2 years - which can be extended to 5 years - had been set for the producer organisations (PO's) in Article

13. This period was introduced to enable PO's to qualify for recognition under the new Regulation. The entry into force for this specific provision had been set on 21 November 1996 while the date of application for the whole Regulation was set on 1 January 1997. The adopted Regulation (the Italian delegation voting against) intends to correct this mistake by amending Article 13 and setting the beginning of the transitional period on 1 January 1997. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 12/11/2002.?
