EC/Russia agreement on cooperation in science and technology: renewal

PURPOSE : to conclude an Agreement which aims to renew the original Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the EC and Russia. CONTENT : the original Agreement referred to above entered into force on 10 May 2001 and was concluded for an initial period ending on 31 December 2002. The Agreement stated that it would be renewable by common agreement between the Parties for an additional period of five years. On 19 September, the Russian government requested a rapid renewal, without change to the text of the Agreement, so as to maintain continuity in the scientific and technological relations between Russia and the EC. Since both parties desire rapid renewal, a one-step procedure is suggested (a single procedure and a single act concerning signature and conclusion). The Commission therefore requests the Council to conclude the Agreement aimed at renewing the original Agreement and to authorise designation of the person empowered to sign the Agreement.?

PURPOSE : to conclude the Agreement aimed at renewing the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and the Government of the Russian Federation. LEGISLATIVE ACT : Council Decision 2003/798/EC concerning the conclusion of an Agreement aimed at renewing the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and the Government of the Russian Federation. CONTENT : the Agreement aimed at renewing the Agreement on cooperation in science and technology between the European Community and the Government of the Russian Federation for an additional period of five years is hereby approved on behalf of the Community. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 5 June 2003. The existing Agreement, which entered into force in May 2001, was concluded for an initial period until 31 December 2002, renewable by common agreement for additional period of five years, therefore 1 January 2003 until 31 December 2007.?
