Hops: common organisation of the market CMO, extension of the aid to 2004 (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 1696/71)

PURPOSE : to extend Regulation 1696/71/EEC on the common organisation of the market in hops. PROPOSED ACT : Council Regulation.
 CONTENT : Council Regulation 1696/71/EEC fixes the aid per hectare for hops produced in the Community for a period of eight years, from the 1996 to the 2003 harvests. The assessment report that the Commission is required to present to the Council by 31 December 2003 will cover all provisions relating to the common organisation of the market, in particular the production aid scheme. The assessment can be accompanied by proposals. It is advisable in this context to provide for a detailed debate of the entire sector. In order to ensure a thorough debate, it is proposed that the period for which the aid has been fixed should be extended by one year. A producer group can withhold up to 20% of the aid to finance special measures for adjusting to the market and the amounts withheld can accumulate for a period of three years. As it is proposed to extend the aid scheme for a year, the maximum accumulation period should also be extended for a year. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS : - budget heading : B1-181; - appropriations : EUR 13 million.?

PURPOSE : to extend Regulation 1696/71/EEC on the common organisation of the market in hops. LEGISLATIVE ACT : Council Regulation 2320/2003/EC amending Regulation 1696/71/EEC on the common organisation of the market in hops. CONTENT : the Council adopted this Regulation on the common organisation of the market in hops. It stipulates that Article 12(5) of Regulation 1696/71/EEC shall be amended as follows: - the aid per hectare shall be the same for all groups of varieties. For nine years from the 1996 harvest it shall amount to EUR 480/ha; - the aid withheld may be accumulated for a maximum period of four years; at the end of that period all aid withheld must have been spent. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 7 January 2004. ?
