Honey: application of measures to improve the production and marketing

PURPOSE : to lay down general rules for the application of measures to improve the production and marketing of honey. CONTENT : the purpose of this proposal is to undertake a codification of Council Regulation 1221/97/EC of 25 June 1997 laying down general rules for the application of measures to improve the production and marketing of honey. The new Regulation will supersede the various acts incorporated in it. This proposal fully preserves the content of the acts being codified and hence does no more than bringing them together with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.?

Honey: application of measures to improve the production and marketing

?Following the screening exercise of proposals pending undertaken as part of its effort for better regulation in the framework of the Partnership for Growth and Jobs in the European Union, the Commission has decided to withdraw certain proposals on which the Legislator has not yet reached a decision and which were found not to be consistent with the Lisbon and Better Regulation criteria, unlikely to make further progress in the legislative process or found to be no longer topical for objective reasons?.
