Minimum stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum products. Codification

PURPOSE : a codification of Council Directive 68/414/EEC imposing an obligation on Member States of the EEC to maintain minimum stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum. PROPOSED ACT : Council Directive. CONTENT : under an EU drive to codify legislation with more than 10 amendments the Commission is presenting this codified version of a Council Directive. The new Directive will supersede the various acts incorporated in it whilst at the same time fully preserving the content of the acts being codified. The only amendments that exist are formal and are there for the purpose of codification. The codification was drawn up on the basis of a preliminary consolidation and the instruments amending it by means of a data processing system.?

The European Parliament adopted a resolution drafted by Giuseppe GARGANI (EPP-ED, IT) and approved the Commission's proposal.

Minimum stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum products. Codification

PURPOSE: to oblige Member States to maintain minimum stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum products.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Directive 2006/67/EC of 24 July 2006 imposing an obligation on Member States to maintain minimum stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum products (codified version).

CONTENT: The Council adopted a Directive (codified version) obliging Member States to maintain a minimum level of stocks of crude oil and/or petroleum products.

This Directive codifies and repeals directive 68/414/EEC, substituting the various acts incorporated in it by bringing them together with only such amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 28/08/2006.
