## EC/Mexico Economic Partnership, Political Coordination and Cooperation Agreement: Protocol following the 2004 enlargement

**PURPOSE** : to conclude an Additional Protocol to the Economic Partnership, Political Coordination and Cooperation Agreement between the Community and Mexico.

**PROPOSED ACT** : Council Decision.

**CONTENT** : according to Article 6(2) of the Act of Accession of the new Member States to the EU, the accession of the new EU Member States to the EU-Mexico Economic Partnership, Political co-ordination and Cooperation Agreement is to be agreed by means of an additional protocol to this Agreement. The same article provides for a simplified procedure, whereby the protocol is to be concluded by the Council, acting unanimously on behalf of the Member States and by the third country concerned. This procedure is without prejudice to the Community's own competences.

The text of the protocol negotiated with Mexico is attached.

**PURPOSE:** the taking into account of the accession of 10 new Member States to EU membership in relation to the Additional Protocol to the Economic Partnership, Political Coordination and Cooperation Agreement between the EC and Mexico .

**LEGISLATIVE ACT:** Council Decision 2005/202/EC.

**CONTENT:** This Council Decision relates to the approval of the conclusion of an Additional Protocol to the Economic Partnership, Political Coordination and Cooperation Agreement between the EC, of the one part, and Mexico, on the other, to take account of the accession of the Czech Republic, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Slovenia, and the Slovak Republic to the European Union.
