Prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies (TSEs): extension of the period for transitional measures

The committee adopted the report by Dagmar ROTH-BEHRENDT (PES, DE) amending the proposal under the 1st reading of the codecision procedure. It called for the proposal to be split into two parts, in order to prolong the transitional measures on the one hand, and leave sufficient time to discuss the necessary revision of the TSE regulation on the other hand. The committee proposed to deal only with the issue of transitional measures and amended the title of the proposal accordingly. It also called for these measures to be extended until 1 July 2007 pending the revision of permanent measures as well as the creation of an overall strategy on TSEs. Lastly, it said that the regulation should enter into force on 1 July 2005.

Prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies (TSEs): extension of the period for transitional measures

PURPOSE: extension of the period for transitional measures for the prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Regulation 932/2005/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation 999/2001/EC laying down rules for the prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies as regards the extension of the period for transitional measures.

CONTENT: [to recall](#), Regulation 999/2001/EC is intended to provide a single legal framework for transmissible spongiform encephalopathies (TSEs) in the Community. Regulation 1128/2003/EC amending Regulation 999/2001/EC as regards the extension of the period for transitional measures prolonged the period of application of the transitional measures provided for in Regulation 999/2001/EC until 1 July 2005 at the latest.

In order to ensure legal certainty beyond the expiry of the transitional measures provided for in Regulation 999/2001/EC and pending the revision of permanent measures as well as the creation of an overall strategy on TSEs, it is appropriate to extend those transitional measures further until 1 July 2007.

More specifically, the second paragraph of Art 23 of Regulation 999/2001/EC is amended to provide that transitional measures shall be adopted for a period ending on 1 July 2007 at the latest, to permit the change-over from the current arrangements to the arrangements established in that Regulation.
