PROPOSED ACT: Council Regulation

CONTENT: In line with the wording of the 2005 Strategy Paper on enlargement and in order to be consistent with Turkey?s Accession Partnership status the Commission is proposing to change the name of Croatia?s Partnership title from ?European? to ?Accession?. This would bring it in line with Turkey, which like Croatia, has begun accession negotiations.

CONTENT: the Council adopted a regulation amending regulation 533/2004 by changing the name of the "European partnership" for Croatia to "accession partnership" in order to align the name with that used for the partnership for Turkey, as both are candidate countries that have

started accession negotiations on their accession to the EU.
