PURPOSE: to codify Council Directive 75/322/EEC on the suppression of radio interference produced by agricultural or forestry tractors (electromagnetic compatibility).

PROPOSED ACT: Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council.

CONTENT: the purpose of this proposal is to codify EU provisions on Council Directive 75/322/EEC on the suppression of radio interference produced by agricultural or forestry tractors (electromagnetic compatibility). In codifying legislative acts that have been amended frequently the EU is seeking to both simplify and clarify EU legislation.

The new Directive will supersede the various acts incorporated in it. It fully preserves the content of the acts being codified and hence does no more than bring them together, with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.

The Committee on Legal Affairs adopted the report drafted by Mr Francesco Enrico SPERONI (UEN, IT) approving, under the first reading of the codecision procedure, the proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the suppression of radio interference (electromagnetic compatibility) produced by agricultural or forestry tractors (codified version).

Although the proposal was not the subject of formal amendments by the committee, the proposal does however include recommendations from the Consultative Working Party, consisting of the legal services of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission, who made a certain number of technical remarks regarding the text of the codified proposal.

The text of the proposal has been amended accordingly.

Apart from these aspects, the proposal is a straightforward codification of existing texts, without any change in their substance.
