## 2007 discharge: European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions EUROFOUND

**PURPOSE:** to present the final accounts of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for the financial year 2007.

**CONTENT:** this document sets out a detailed account of the implementation of the Foundation's budget for 2007. It indicates that the Foundation's final budget amounted to EUR 20.2 million in 2007 (compared with EUR 19.8 million in 2006).

With regard to staff, the Foundation - with headquarters in Dublin (Ireland) - has 94 posts available of which 84 are occupied, and 13 other members of staff (Seconded National Experts, employment agency staff and Contract Agents), which is equivalent to a total staff of 97 undertaking operating activities, administrative tasks and mixed duties.

In 2007, the work undertaken by the Foundation included:

Monitoring and surveys:

- The European Industrial Relations Observatory (EIRO), the European Working Conditions Observatory (EWCO) and the European Restructuring Monitor (ERM);
- 4th European Working Conditions Survey: secondary analysis (themes of gender and working conditions, ageing workforce, work organisation, working time and work intensity, etc.);
- European survey on working time and work-life balance: five reports published in 2007.

Employment and restructuring:

- Undeclared work;
- European Restructuring Monitor case studies;
- Stakeholder enquiry service.

Work-life balance and working conditions:

- Attractive workplace for all;
- Flexibility and security over the life course;
- Changes in the job structure.

Industrial relations and partnership:

- Codes of conduct and framework agreements;
- Capacity building for sectoral and local level; social dialogue in the EU 10;
- Working time and industrial relations.

Social cohesion and quality of life:

- Role of local authorities in the integration of migrants;
- Developments in childcare services in disadvantaged areas;
- Promoting quality of life in rural Europe.

Communication and sharing ideas and experience:

- 376 publications, 1.57 million users sessions (average of 4 303/day);
- 37 press activities, 45 press releases, up 28% on 2006;

- 1 126 article cuttings with advertising value equivalent (AVE) of EUR 2.1 million, reaching ca 58 765 000 people, up 80% from 2006;
- Promotion campaign ?Fourth Working Conditions Survey: what workers say?, ?Quality of Life in Turkey?;
- Roadshows in five countries;
- Company Network Seminars on Diversity in Europe and Environmental Changes;
- Foundation Seminar Series ?Youth and Work?;
- National Outreach Centres covering 10 Members States;
- 16 exhibitions;
- 58 visits to the Foundation, including the Finnish President.

The Committee on Budgetary Control adopted the report drawn up by Christofer FJELLNER (EPP-ED, SE) on discharge to be granted to the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions, calling on the European Parliament to grant the Executive Director of the Foundation discharge in respect of the implementation of its budget for the financial year 2007.

Noting that the Foundation?s annual accounts for the financial year 2007 are reliable, and the underlying transactions are legal and regular, MEPs approve the closure of the Foundation?s accounts.

However, they make a number of recommendations as part of the decision on discharge. In addition to the general recommendations appearing in the draft resolution on financial management and control of EU agencies (see [2008/2207\(INI\)](#)), MEPs make the following observations:

- in relation to weaknesses in recruitment procedures, MEPs regret that in 2007, as in 2006, the European Court of Auditors (ECA) found weaknesses in recruitment procedures. Although measures have been taken, the Court notes that they do not ensure transparent and non-discriminatory recruitment procedures. MEPs therefore call on the Foundation to pay particular attention to the legality of its recruitment procedures and to specify, in its annual activity report for 2008, the action taken in follow-up to the ECA's observations;
- in relation to weaknesses in procurement procedures, MEPs regret the anomalies identified by the Court, which considers that they affected the quality of the final selection procedure. They therefore call on the Foundation to also specify, in its annual activity report for 2008, the action taken in follow-up to the ECA's observations;
- in relation to the introduction of Accrual Based Accounting (ABAC), MEPs are satisfied that the Foundation introduced ABAC in 2008, although they note anomalies in terms of assigned revenue;
- in relation to follow-up to the previous discharge exercise, MEPs recall that, in 2006, the Foundation launched an ex-post evaluation of the 2001-2004 work programme, with a view to determining the organisation's impact. MEPs call on the Foundation to inform them of the results of the evaluation in time for the 2008 discharge exercise.

The European Parliament adopted a decision concerning the discharge to be granted to the Director of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions discharge in respect of the implementation of its budget for the financial year 2007. The decision to grant discharge is also an approval of the closure of the accounts of this EU agency.

In parallel, the European Parliament adopted by 405 votes to 13, with 19 abstentions, a resolution with observations which are an integral part of the decision to grant discharge.

Parliament notes that certain weaknesses can be found in the following areas:

- recruitment process: Parliament regrets that in 2007, as in 2006, the European Court of Auditors (ECA) found weaknesses in recruitment procedures. Although measures have been taken, the Court notes that they do not ensure transparent and non-discriminatory recruitment procedures. Parliament therefore calls on the Foundation to pay particular attention to the legality of its recruitment procedures and to specify, in its annual activity report for 2008, the action taken in follow-up to the ECA's observations;
- procurement procedures: Parliament regrets the anomalies identified by the Court, which considers that they affected the quality of the final selection procedure. It therefore calls on the Foundation to also specify, in its annual activity report for 2008, the action taken in follow-up to the ECA's observations;
- as regards the introduction of Accrual Based Accounting (ABAC): Parliament is satisfied that the Foundation introduced ABAC in 2008, although it notes anomalies in terms of assigned revenue;
- in relation to follow-up to the previous discharge exercise: Parliament recalls that, in 2006, the Foundation launched an ex-post evaluation of the 2001-2004 work programme, with a view to determining the organisation's impact. It calls on the Foundation to inform them of the results of the evaluation in time for the 2008 discharge exercise.

Lastly, noting that the Foundation?s annual accounts for the financial year 2007 are reliable, and the underlying transactions are legal and regular, the Parliament approves the closure of its accounts and refers, for other observations accompanying its decision on discharge, to its resolution on financial management and control of EU agencies - see [2008/2207\(INI\)](#) - adopted in parallel.

**PURPOSE:** to grant discharge to the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for the financial year 2007.

**LEGISLATIVE ACT:** Decision 2009/677/EC of the European Parliament on the discharge for implementation of the budget of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for the financial year 2007.

**CONTENT:** with the present decision, the European Parliament grants discharge to the Director of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for the financial year 2007.

This decision is in line with the European Parliament's resolution adopted on 23 April 2009 and comprises a series of observations that form an integral part of the discharge decision (please refer to the summary of the opinion of 23/04/2009). The decision to grant discharge is also an approval of the closure of the accounts of this EU agency.
