Freedom of information in Italy and other EU Member States

The House held a debate, following on the Commission statement, on freedom of information in Italy and other EU Member States.

A motion for a resolution closing this debate was due to be put to the vote at the next part-session.

Freedom of information in Italy and other EU Member States

Following the debate held on 8 October 2009 at its part-session in Brussels, the European Parliament held a vote on the nine draft resolutions that were tabled on freedom of information in Italy and other EU Member States. All the resolutions were rejected, including two joint resolutions tabled, respectively, by the EPP, ECR and EFD groups and the S&D, ALDE, Greens/EFA and GUE groups. The other resolutions were tabled by the individual political groups.

The results of the vote on the nine resolutions were as follows (in order of voting):

Joint resolution by the EPP, ECR and EFD groups: 297/322/25

Resolution by the EPP group: 258/347/73

Resolution by the ECR group: 301/351/26

Joint resolution by the S&D, ALDE, Greens/EFA and GUE/NGL groups: 335/338/13

Resolution by the Greens/EFA group: 321/346/8

Resolution by the EFD group: 257/399/20

Resolution by the GUE/NGL group: rejected by show of hands

Resolution by the S&D group: 333/345/5

Resolution by the ALDE group: 338/338/8.
