State of play of the peace process for the Middle East

Ministers discussed the Middle East Peace Process during their working lunch, following a briefing by the High Representative on the Quartet meeting on 5 February 2011 and on the follow-up to the proposals for a package of measures to support Gaza.

The High Representative also reported on her recent visit to the region, which included, Lebanon, Israel, the Palestinian Territories and Jordan. Ministers reaffirmed the need for urgent progress in the peace process.

State of play of the peace process for the Middle East

The House held a debate, following on the statement by the Vice-President of the Commission and High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, on the state of play of the peace process for the Middle East.

The debate was not followed by the adoption of a resolution.
