The Committee on Constitutional Affairs, which had been consulted on the application of Rule 191(1) of the Rules of Procedure, provided the following interpretation on that provision:

'Only full members of a committee, elected in accordance with Article 186, may be elected to the bureau of that committee.'

EP Rules of Procedure, Rule 191: committee bureau; interpretation

The European Parliament adopted a decision concerning eligibility for membership of the bureau of a committee (interpretation of Rule 191(1) of Parliaments Rules of Procedure).

Parliament decided to append the following interpretation to Rule 191(1) of its Rules of Procedure:

Only full members of a committee who have been elected in accordance with Rule 186 may be elected to the bureau of that committee.
