Fishery products originating in Ceuta: live fry and juveniles of sea bream and bass, community tariff quota

This proposal aimed to allow for the opening up of a Community tariff quota, exempt from customs duties, for the import of up to 3 000 000 live fry and juveniles of sea bream and bass originating in Ceuta. This annual quota, requested by Spain in accordance with Protocol No 2 annexed to the Act of Accession of Spain and Portugal, would be extended to the year 2000. ?

Parliament approved the Commission proposal without amendments. ?

Fishery products originating in Ceuta: live fry and juveniles of sea bream and bass, community tariff quota

OBJECTIVE: to open a Community tariff quota for live fry and juveniles of sea bream and bass originating in Ceuta. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Regulation (EC) No 1326/95. SUBSTANCE: the Regulation allows for the opening of a Community tariff quota, exempt from customs duties, for the import of up to 3 000 000 live fry and juveniles of sea bream and bass originating in Ceuta. This quota is initially opened from 1 January 1995 to 31 December 1995. It is administered by the Commission, which may take all appropriate measures to ensure efficient administration thereof. To ensure efficient joint administration of these quotas, Member States may be authorised to draw from the quota volume the necessary amount corresponding to actual imports. The Regulation shall enter into force on 9 June 1995 and shall apply with effect from 1 January 1995. ?
