Support system for producers of certain arable crops (amend. Regul. 1765/92/EEC)

The proposal for a Council regulation concerned two types of measures applicable from the 1995/96 marketing year: - providing for aid of ECU 115/ha for a limited area of 50 000 ha of durum wheat, outside the traditional zones in France, and providing for an increase in the areas recognised as traditional areas for the production of durum wheat in Spain (+20 000 ha) and Italy (+ 5 000 ha); - in Germany, providing for different penalties in the various Länder as a result of a simultaneous overrun in the maximum guaranteed area for oilseeds and the national reference area. ?

Support system for producers of certain arable crops (amend. Regul. 1765/92/EEC)

The committee adopted the report on two Commission proposals to modify support arrangements for durum wheat and oilseeds. On durum wheat, members agreed with the Commission that some production should be maintained outside the traditional production regions, by granting a specific aid set at ECU 115/ha. This will affect a maximum of 50 000 ha in France, as well as providing for an increase in the production zones of Spain (+20 000 ha), Portugal (+5 000 ha) and Italy (+5 000 ha). The rapporteur reminded members that a decision on this matter was urgent as the sowing season was about to start and farmers needed to know, as soon as possible, about measures which had immediate implications for the running of their farms. On oilseeds, the committee accepted the Commission proposals to provide for different penalties in the different Länder of Germany as a result of an overrun in the national production quota. The Commission did not want to penalise all producers in the same way, since although some Länder were expected to exceed their quotas by 50%, most had complied with their quotas. The committee adopted several amendments to the Commission proposals to take better account of the specific problems of the new German Länder. ?

Support system for producers of certain arable crops (amend. Regul. 1765/92/EEC)

Parliament approved the Commission proposal subject to three amendments. These amendments aimed to: - enable Member States to apply voluntary self restraint with regard to arable areas likely to be guaranteed by setting target sizes; - enable Member States which had regionalised their base area to aggregate between regions the sown areas for which aid had been claimed; - enable the Commission to authorise the Member States to take appropriate measures to avoid an excessive overrun of the maximum guaranteed area. (The Commission did not accept this amendment.) ?

The Council regulation made certain changes to the support system for producers of certain arable crops (durum wheat, oilseeds). The new regulation covered two types of measures applicable from the 1995/96 financial year: - granting aid of ECU 115/ha for a limited area of 50 000 ha of durum wheat, outside the traditional zones in France, and providing for an increase in the areas recognised as traditional areas for the production of durum wheat in Spain (+20 000 ha), Portugal (+5 000 ha) and Italy (+5 000 ha); - in Germany, providing for different penalties in the various Länder as a result of a simultaneous overrun in the maximum guaranteed area for oilseeds and the national reference area; - enabling the Member States to limit areas for which a producer could receive specific compensatory payments for sowing oilseeds. ?
