Intervention threshold mechanism in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector

As from 1.01.1995, and as a result of the enlargement of the European Union, the intervention threshold mechanism in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector needed to be adapted in order to bring it into line with production in the three new Member States. The amendment proposed by the Commission relates to tomatoes, apples, cauliflower and peaches, the only products produced in the new Member States which are subject to a threshold. - for apples, this amendment would apply from the 1994/1995 marketing year; - for tomatoes, peaches and cauliflower, the amendment of the thresholds and overruns would only apply from the 1995/1996 marketing year. ?

The European Parliament approved this proposal for a regulation in accordance with the procedure laid down in Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure (procedure without report). ?

Intervention threshold mechanism in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector

OBJECTIVE: to adapt, from 1 January 1995, the intervention threshold mechanism in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector in line with production in the three new Member States of the European Union. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Regulation amending Regulations (EEC) No 1035/72, (EEC) No 2240/88 and (EEC) No 1121/89 as regards the intervention threshold mechanism in the fresh fruit and vegetables sector. SUBSTANCE: The amendment introduced by the Regulation relates to tomatoes, apples, cauliflower and peaches, the only products produced in the new Member States that are subject to a threshold. - For apples, this amendment shall apply from the 1994/95 marketing year; - For tomatoes, peaches and cauliflower, the amendment of the thresholds and overruns shall only apply from the 1995/96 marketing year.?
