Joint European Torus JET: amending the statutes (amend. dec. 78/471/Euratom)

OBJECTIVE: to amend the Statutes of the Joint European Torus (JET), Joint Undertaking with a view to continuing JET's operation beyond 1996. SUBSTANCE: the proposed amendments relate mainly to the following points concerning the Statutes: - the JET programme is extended by three years: the joint undertaking is to run until 31 December 1999; - the Finnish member, the Technology Development Centre of Finland (TEKES), must be included among the members of the joint undertaking; - membership of and voting rights on the JET Council: Finland will have two representatives with two votes between them; this will increase the total number of votes in the JET Council from 43 to 45. The total number of votes required to adopt a decision will increase from 29 to 30; - certain changes are taken into account as a result of Sweden's accession to the European Union. ?

Joint European Torus JET: amending the statutes (amend. dec. 78/471/Euratom)

The ESC approved all of the amendments to the statutes of the Joint European Torus (JET), joint undertaking. As regards more specifically the proposal to extend the life of the joint undertaking, it noted that this did not affect the total expenditure allocated to the fusion programme for 1994-1998. Since the ESC had already approved this expenditure, which incorporated the appropriations required to cover the cost of extending the life of the JET joint undertaking, it had no reason to query the Commission?s proposal.
